The Bible Challenge - Week of July 16

This week, we will finish the book of Psalms. It may seem odd that, now that we've finished, we turn right around and start reading Psalm 1 again.

Of course, you can decide to skip that the second time around. It would certainly save a little time (though I feel like the reading might be getting a bit easier as time goes on, Job notwithstanding). But, I hope you will consider sticking with the schedule. The Psalms are a nice break between the Old and New Testaments – sort of like the sung Gospel acclamation in church on Sunday (at the 8 and 9:30 services). And, it's possible that when you read them this time, you will recognize some of the stories and laments that we read earlier in the Old Testament, and how they are re-told by the Psalms to become part of the way the Jewish people understand themselves and God.

Here is this week's reading schedule:

Monday: Job 10-12; Psalm 149; II Corinthians 8

Tuesday: Job 13-15; Psalm 150; II Corinthians 9

Wednesday: Job 16-18; Psalm 1; II Corinthians 10

Thursday: Job 19-21; Psalm 2; II Corinthians 11

Friday: Job 22-24; Psalm 3; II Corinthians 12

Saturday: Job 25-27; Psalm 4; II Corinthians 13
