The Bible Challenge - Week of July 30

This week, we read the book of Ephesians in its entirety. Unlike the other epistles we have read thus far, scholars are a little more unsure about who wrote Ephesians, or indeed whether the letter was written to the church in Ephesus at all (there are indications that the phrase “in Ephesus” was a later addition to the letter). We do know that the letter surfaced around 80 AD, and seems to focus on what kind of life a Christian should lead (which may have been greatly influenced by the desire not to bring the fledgling Christian community into disrepute).

Here is this week’s reading schedule:

Monday: Proverbs 4-6; Psalm 11; Ephesians 1

Tuesday: Proverbs 7-9; Psalm 12; Ephesians 2

Wednesday: Proverbs 10-12; Psalm 13; Ephesians 3

Thursday: Proverbs 13-15; Psalm 14; Ephesians 4

Friday: Proverbs 16-19; Psalm 15; Ephesians 5

Saturday: Proverbs 20-22; Psalm 16; Ephesians 6
