The Bible Challenge

This week, we will begin the second book of Chronicles. Again, this book closely parallels much of what we have read in the books of 1 and 2 Kings. There are some slight differences, however, as we look at the descriptions of the construction of the Temple, and the explanation of how civil war came to the promised land of Israel.

We haven't spent much time talking about the psalm selections. This week, however, it's worth noting that we begin a series of psalms known as "the psalms of ascents," psalms 120-134.

The book of psalms is basically like our hymn book today. Our hymnal is divided into sections, and some of those hymns are sung at particular times, like the Christmas carols, or the hymns about the Eucharist. Likewise, scholars believe that the psalms of ascents were sung at particular times, corresponding to the annual trips by faithful Jews to the Holy City of Jerusalem for Holy Days. These psalms, therefore, are full of references to the greatness of the city of Jerusalem, and the preparations for meeting God on this holy journey.
